#### **Annual Parish Council Meeting**

The Annual Parish Council Meeting, to which all residents are invited, will be at 7pm on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023 in St Mary's. The agenda will be posted on our website, on Facebook and copies will also be on the village noticeboard and in St Mary's near the Post Office.

This will be the first meeting of the new Parish Council following the elections on 4<sup>th</sup> May. However, as there were only 4 nominees (for 7 places), they are all duly elected. The current Vice Chair, Chris Turner, will preside at the start of the meeting while the new Councillors elect their Chair.

#### **Cottam Solar Project**

Sturton and Stow and Stow Parish Councils have reconvened the Sturton and Stow Neighbourhood Planning Group to look at the Cottam proposals against the Neighbourhood Plan policies and then also to review the Plan against the revised Central Lincolnshire Local Plan. They held their first meeting on 4<sup>th</sup> April and have allocated out the work and will reconvene in May to check progress.

This should enable both Councils to better respond to the Planning Inspectorate. If you registered an interest in responding you should hear from the Inspectorate in due course. 3

#### VACANCY FOR COUNCILLORS

There are currently vacancies on the Council and having been through the prescribed procedure, no election has been requested.

The vacancies will therefore now be filled by the cooption process at a meeting of the parish council on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023

Should anyone wish to be considered for these vacancies, they should apply in writing to the council at the address below, by no later than **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023** 

Section 79(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that, unless disqualified, a person is qualified to be co-opted as a local councillor if they are over 18, a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or a Euro national on the day of their selection and:

- on that day he/she is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority; or
- he/she has during the whole of the twelve months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in that area; or
- c. his/her principal or only place of work during that twelve months has been in that area; or
- d. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided in that area; or
- e. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided either in the parish or community or within three miles of it.

There is an application form to be completed.
