

Stow Parish Council have outlined the following objectives for the period year ending 31st March 2027:

1. Priority – Land registry

Registration of the Parish Council Land, namely the Play Park and Parish field, to safeguard the land for remaining generations of Stow residents.

Action Required: *This work commenced in 2025/6 and an application for land registration is now in progress. Cllr Eden continues to lead on this project until completion.*

2. Priority – National Infrastructure Projects

Continue to monitor and respond to the many ongoing planning for major national infrastructure projects that will impact on the village and on stow residents

Action Required: *This work entails a whole council approach, due to the time and resource required. This also requires and utilises the expertise of residents in Stow and the neighbouring villages to support with responses and ensuring deadlines are met. It will also be important to continue working with our WLDC and LCC councillors to ensure that the views and experiences of Stow residents are understood and reflected at district and county level.*

3. Priority 3 – Financial Sustainability

Proactively explore funding opportunities that provide income to support activities of value to the parish and its' residents.

Action Required: *This work relies on continuous review of information sources that identify available grants, alongside proactive exploration of funding streams both locally and nationally relevant to specific activities that the parish council wish to undertake.*
